

Seniors CONCERT

— MEMBERS ONLY —

The Seniors Concert guidelines have been amended from 2022 to comply with the current COVID Regulations and ensure the smooth return of this event.

1. General

- All attendees must be a financial member of Revesby Workers' Club.
- No concert is held in January.
- February to November concerts will be held on **third Tuesday** of each month.
- The December 'Christmas' concert will be held on the **second Tuesday** of the month and the ticketing includes a meal.
- No access to the Whitlam Theatre is permitted prior to **doors opening at 12.45pm**. Attendees found in the room prior this time will be asked to leave and wait in the Function Centre Foyer at the back of the queue.
- All attendees must present a concert ticket to staff upon entry into the Whitlam Theatre. No access will be granted without a ticket.
- Attendees must be seated at the correct table and seat as stipulated on their ticket.
- Please note that all purchases are final and non-refundable.
- The Club reserves the right to amend and / or review these guidelines at any time and will advise members of any change/s at the next scheduled concert date.

2. Concert Ticketing

- Seniors Concert tickets for **February to November concerts will cost members \$2.00 each**. This is a \$2.00 Donation to the Bill Bullard Charity Foundation.
- Seniors Concert tickets for **December, the Christmas Concert, will cost members \$2.00 each**. This includes a \$2.00 Donation to the Bill Bullard Charity Foundation and a 2-Course Christmas Lunch.
- **Seniors Concert Dining Specials replace the previous Meal Tickets**. These specials are available to purchase directly from Firestone Kitchen on the day of the concert. There is no requirement to pre-purchase.
- **Seniors Concert tickets will be available for members following the current month's concert, between the hours of 3pm on concert day until 7pm on Sunday of the same week from Club Reception**, except for February Seniors Concerts.

- Members wishing to keep their same Seat / Table for the next concert must present their current Seniors Concert ticket to Club Reception during the above-mentioned time. Following this time, any available ticket may be purchased.
- Seniors Concert tickets for February will be available on the third Monday in January from 10am to 4pm for all December Christmas concert attendees. Following this time, any available ticket may be purchased.
- A member is permitted to purchase up to **two (2) Seniors Concert Tickets** only at one time, upon presentation of both financial membership cards.
- Seniors Concert Tickets **cannot be held or reserved**.
- Once a ticket is issued, the member must make all attempts to attend the concert. If the member cannot attend, **no refund** on the \$2.00 donation will be issued as per the Club's standard ticketing terms and conditions.

4. Service NSW COVID Safe Check In

- Each member attending the Seniors Concert will be required to Check In via the Service NSW COVID Safe Check-In.
- This is a Government mandated obligation. Each person's Check-In **MUST** be sighted by a GRO staff member to gain access to the Club's premises. NO Check In means NO Entry.

COVID Safe Check In can be done in two (2) ways;

1. Use the **QR Code** displayed in the Car Park or Club Entry (Smartphone Users)
2. Use the **Tablet** at Club Reception (Non-Smartphone Users)

The Service NSW COVID Safe Check In procedure is to ensure the NSW Government have a complete and accurate record of all persons entering the Club premises, which may be used at any time for contact tracing.
